## Purpose

To provide Council with the necessary information to provide comment to the Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch (LCRB) regarding Change to Hours of Liquor Service (After Midnight) for Grand Forks Station Pub & Restaurant (164601) located at 7654 Donaldson Drive.

## **Background**

The Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch (LCRB) has received an application to Change Hours of Liquor Service (After Midnight) for Grand Forks Station Pub & Restaurant (164601) located at 7654 Donaldson Drive. Before the LCRB can decide whether to issue the licence, Local Governments must first gather input for the community within the immediate vicinity of the establishment and provide comments on the application. Alternatively, Council may also choose to delegate the authority of providing comment on the application to Staff.

Comments to the LCRB regarding a Lounge Area Endorsement must speak clearly to the following items:

- The impact of noise on the community in the immediate vicinity of the establishment
- The impact on the community if the application is approved
- The views of residents, and a description of the method used to gather views
- The local government's recommendations (including whether the application should be approved) and the reasons on which they are based

#### These comments must consider:

- The location of the establishment
- The proposed hours of service
- The person capacity of the establishment

#### **Hours**

The applicant proposes to change the hours of liquor service as follows:

Proposed Changes:	<b>Current Approved Hours</b>	Proposed Hours
Monday-Thursday	10AM-12AM	10AM-1AM
Friday-Saturday	11AM-1AM	10AM-1AM
Sunday	11AM-12AM	10AM-1AM

Staff note that although the application information on the LCRB licencing portal indicates that the applicant requested a closing time of 6:00pm on Sundays, staff subsequently confirmed with the applicant that this was a mistake, and their request is for a closing time of 1:00am on Sundays.

## **Proposed Comments:**

The following table lays out the required components of comments that must be made to the LCRB regarding a Lounge Area Endorsement and Staff's recommended comments.

Requirement	Comment
The impact of noise on the community in the immediate vicinity of the establishment	Noise is not expected to be an issue due to the neighbourhood commercial location of the business which is on a busy collector road.
The impact on the community if the application is approved	If the application is approved, the impact is expected to be positive in that it will support the growth of the local economy and offer expanded hours for a social venue for residents. The hours of service are acceptable.
The views of residents, and a description of the method used to gather views	responses were received from the public. The public was invited to participate in a public feedback session on July 11th, 2022, which was advertised in the local newspaper on June 29 <sup>th</sup> , 2022. The newspaper ad also invited the public to submit written feedback which would be taken until noon on July 8 <sup>th</sup> , 2022. Comments from the Public

	Feedback Session were:
The local government's recommendations (including whether the application should be approved) and the reasons on which they are based.	Council recommends to approve/not approve the endorsement. The proposed expanded hours of the establishment present no immediate concerns to the City or to the public. This establishment provides jobs and a social venue for residents and visitors and contributes to the local economy and tax base.

## **Benefits or Impacts**

#### General

The expanded hours have the potential to attract more people to the area for longer and support revitalization of the Grand Forks business sector.

#### **Finances**

There are no costs to the City directly associated with the liquor licence. Supporting the LCRB application may lead to stimulation of the local economy by drawing more persons to this area of the community and creating more jobs.
