Bylaw Services Review

- ❖ 3 transient camps removed, 10 currently exist. Many complaints fielded about this
- ❖ 3 unsightly property issues resolved, several new complaints received
- ❖ 2 random dumping issues resolved
- ❖ 42 watering violations recorded
- ❖ Motor vehicle and public nuisance behavior issues are on the rise

Building Inspection Review

- ❖ 8 Building Permit applications received in June, yearly total now 45
 - ❖ 2017 construction value now at \$2,343,762.00 (2016 total was \$2,536,774.00)
 - ❖ 13 new residences (4 modular), 11 new commercial renovations under development
 - ❖ Construction inspections and proposal reviews ongoing
